



	<p>1 Mark on the wall so that the wall bracket is straight. Use the correct type of screw for your type of wall (not included).</p>		<p>2 Unscrew the bracket that holds the leather strap.</p>		
	<p>3 Remove the leather strap and save if you want to use it later.</p>		<p>4 Screw back the bracket.</p>		
	<p>5 Ensure that the bracket is screwed on.</p>		<p>6 Hang your Firemill on the folded tab on the wall bracket.</p>		
	<p>7 If you are keeping your Firemill in a mobile environment such as a motorhome or caravan, you can anchor it a little extra with the cable tie. This so that it does not fall down by mistake.</p>		<p>8 Tighten the cable tie around the black part.</p>		
<p>Make sure it goes into the slot on the wall bracket.</p>			<p>9 Make sure you tighten as much as you can.</p>		<p>10 Cut off the excess piece.</p>
<p>Now your Firemill is finally up on the wall, fantastic!</p>
